The term Tariqa is used for a school or order of Sufism, or especially for the mystical teaching and spiritual practices of such an order with the aim of seeking haqīqah (ultimate truth) A tariqa has a murshid (guide) who plays the role of leader or spiritual director The members or followers of a tariqa are known as murīdīn (singular murīd), meaning "desirous", viz "desiring the knowledge of knowing God and loving God"
